Vaccine abbreviations stand for

Rota	rotavirus
D	diphtheria
aP	whooping cough (pertussis)
T	tetanus
P	polio
Hib	<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type B
HBV	hepatitis B
Pneu	pneumococcal disease
M	mumps
M	measles
R	rubella
MenACWY	meningococcal disease types ACWY
HPV	human papillomavirus
V	varicella (the virus that causes 'chickenpox')
