Subject Reminder: second HPV vaccination for your child

Dear parent/carer of <name>,

Several months ago, you received an invitation for your child to get the second vaccination against HPV. According to our records, your child has not yet had this vaccination. Your child can still come and get this second vaccination.

Why is this vaccination necessary?

The human papillomavirus (HPV) is a virus that can cause cancer, such as cervical cancer and cancer of the mouth and throat. The virus is very common. Two vaccinations will give your child effective protection against the different kinds of cancer that can be caused by HPV. The information sheet about HPV offers more information.

Where and when can your child get the vaccinations?

In the envelope, you will find a letter from the Youth Healthcare Services (JGZ). It states where and when your child can get the second vaccination.

What should your child bring along to the vaccination appointment?

- This letter
- The vaccination certificate (which you received from us after your child was born)
- A valid form of ID for your child, such as an ID card or passport

Has your child already had two vaccinations against HPV?

If your child has already had the first vaccination, it was not processed in our records. Or you may not have given consent for the Youth Healthcare Services (JGZ) to share vaccination data with us. If you want us to include the vaccination data in our records, please contact the JGZ location that gave the vaccination.
